*Don't let shame stop you taking steps to protect
yourself and your children*

- Treading carefully?
- Made to do things you don't want to do ?
- Feel unsafe when your partner is angry ?
- Are you called names ?
- No say in financial arrangements ?
- Children sometimes frightened ?

SAFETY FIRST

Let someone know how you feel

- Have a Safety Plan
- Know where you can go and who to contact
- Have easy access to emergency phone numbers
- Pack belongings (extra car keys, copies of important documents, medication, clothes, treasured toys) and leave them with a trusted friend or family member, or hide them
- Pre-arrange a meeting place with children
